#### *Principal's message.....*

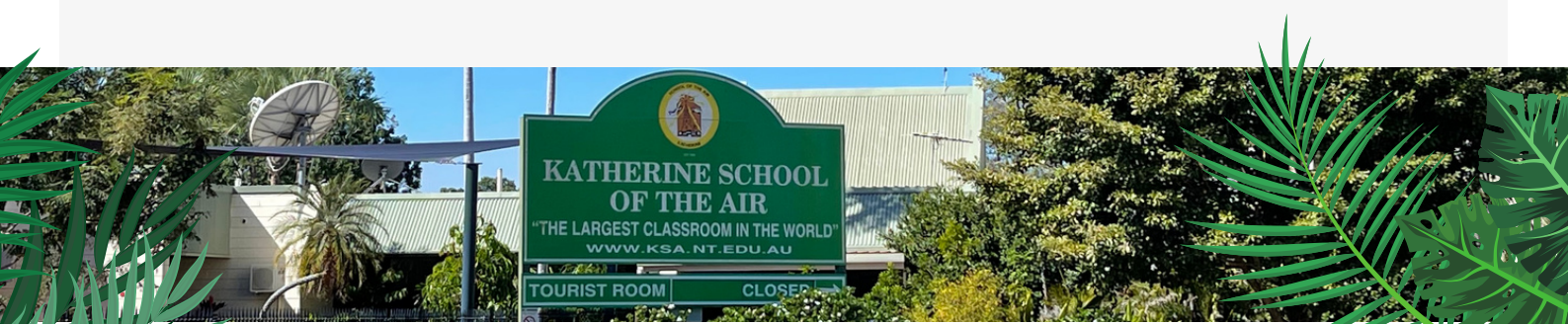
Welcome back to Term 2!
