Please be aware of an email phishing scam that has been making it's way to families recently.

The email says that the sender is Kath Soa, but if you check the email address you can see it is not coming from KSA.

This is harder to notice on mobile devices, as it will sometimes just show Kath Soa as the sender, so a good rule of thumb is to not click any links that are sent to your email without double-checking it's coming from a trusted source.


